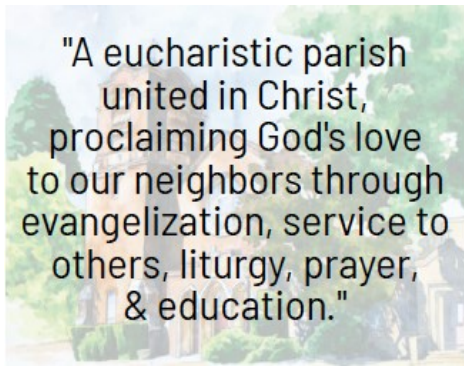

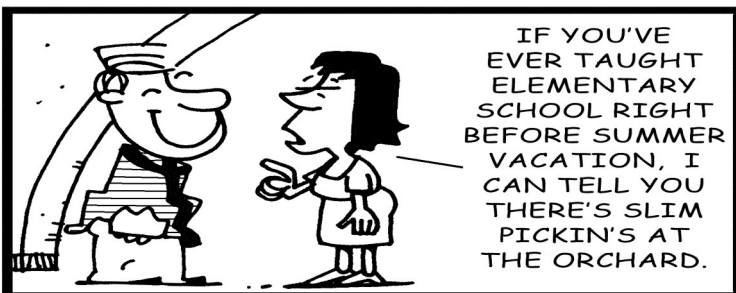

DID YOU KNOW THIS ABOUT ST. MARY?

Rev. Edwin V. O'Hara 1920-1929

During the 1920's the population of Eugene and the surrounding area was rapidly growing. The little church built in 1907 and moved in 1920, which held about 500, was becoming too small. By October 1926, Father O'Hara had acquired almost all of the block bounded by 10th and 11th Streets and Charnelton and Lincoln Streets. He began to plan for a new church to be built on the southeast corner of the property. Ground was broken on February 2, 1927, the Feast of the Purification of Mary, the parish's patronal feast from its beginning. The building was completed in the fall, by October 1. This Church still stands at the corner of 11th and Charnelton and serves as the place of worship for St. Mary's parish.

The new church was complete and the old church could be remodeled for a parish hall. The former sanctuary area was made into a stage and the former sacristy into a kitchen. What had been the nave was used for basketball, volleyball, dancing, recitals, and programs of various kinds.

During all the time he was a pastor, Father O'Hara continued his work as director of the Rural Life Bureau. Each fall he would be gone from two or three weeks to three months to organize National Catholic Rural Life Conferences, to visit dioceses, agricultural colleges, and other places, either to learn more about what could be done to improve rural life or to promote his program of Catholic education for farm populations.

By the end of the year 1928, it became apparent to Father O'Hara and to others that he could no longer keep up the work of a growing parish together with all that he was doing as director of the Rural Life Bureau. Consequently, with the approval of Archbishop Howard, he resigned from the parish and moved the Rural Life Bureau to Washington, D.C.

Soon after leaving Eugene Father O'Hara became Bishop of Great Falls and then Archbishop of Kansas City.

¿SABÍAS ESTO SOBRE SANTA MARÍA?

Rev. Edwin V. O'Hara 1920-1929

Durante la década de 1920, la población de Eugene y sus alrededores estaba creciendo rápidamente. La pequeña iglesia construida en 1907 y trasladada en 1920, que sentarse a unas 500 personas, se estaba quedando pequeña. En octubre de 1926, el padre O'Hara había adquirido casi toda la cuadra delimitada por las calles 10 y 11 y las calles Charnelton y Lincoln. Comenzó a planificar la construcción de una nueva iglesia en la esquina sureste. La construcción se inició el 2 de febrero de 1927, Fiesta de la Purificación de María, fiesta patronal de la parroquia desde sus inicios. El edificio se completó en el otoño, el 1 de octubre. Esta iglesia todavía se encuentra en la esquina de 11th y Charnelton y sirve como lugar de culto para la parroquia de St. Mary.

La nueva iglesia estaba completa y la antigua iglesia podría ser remodelada para un salón parroquial. La antigua zona del santuario se convirtió en escenario y la antigua sacristía en cocina. Lo que había sido la nave fue utilizado para baloncesto, voleibol, bailes, recitales y programas de diversa índole.

Durante todo el tiempo que fue pastor, el Padre O'Hara continuó su labor como director de la Oficina de Vida Rural. Cada otoño se ausentaba por dos o tres semanas a tres meses para organizar Conferencias Nacionales Católicas sobre la Vida Rural, visitar diócesis, colegios agrícolas y otros lugares, ya sea para aprender más sobre lo que se podría hacer para mejorar la vida rural o para promover su Programa de educación católica para poblaciones campesinas.

A finales del año 1928, el Padre O'Hara y otros se dieron cuenta de que ya no podía continuar con el trabajo de una parroquia en crecimiento junto con todo lo que estaba haciendo como director de la Oficina de Vida Rural. En consecuencia, con la aprobación del arzobispo Howard, renunció a la parroquia y trasladó la Oficina de Vida Rural a Washington, D.C.

Poco después de dejar Eugene, el padre O'Hara se convirtió en obispo de Great Falls y luego en arzobispo de Kansas City.
