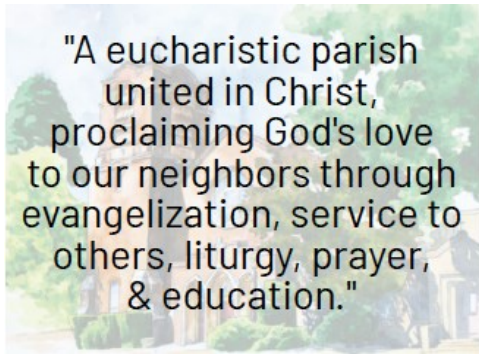

DID YOU KNOW THIS ABOUT ST. MARY?

Rev. Edmund Murnane 1950-1969

Father Edmund J. Murnane became the new pastor of St. Mary in September 1950. His initial priorities were to repair the church and construct a brick addition for offices at the front of the rectory. The addition was connected to the church vestibule by a hallway, housing a new parish library. The library, initially consisting of two hundred books, was a donation from Father Murnane.

In addition, it was necessary to create more classroom space for the school. The establishment of the new St. Francis High School and the opening of a Catholic school at St. Alice in 1953 provided opportunities for children who were previously unable to attend Catholic schools. The post-war "baby boom" resulted in overcrowded conditions in all schools. Consequently, in 1952, plans were initiated to construct a third addition to the existing units built in 1940 and 1947. This addition would consist of a two-story structure with eight classrooms, extending the school the full length of the block between 10th and 11th Streets facing Lincoln Street. Despite efforts to raise \$250,000 for this project, the campaign did not reach its goal, and the plan was never executed.

Father Murnane and others realized that St. Mary's Parish was too large and should be divided into multiple parishes. Money collected in the 1952 campaign was used to buy property in other parts of the city for future parishes. Father Murnane's plan included relocating St. Mary Church to the 18th Street property, financed by selling the Charnelton Street block to commercial interests. However, building shopping centers in suburban areas shifted the city's development and the plan never materialized. Although St. Mary's Church was never relocated, plans for the other parishes moved forward. A ten-acre tract in the River Road district and a twenty-six-acre tract in the Washington School District became the sites for St. Peter and St. Paul parishes respectively. In 1954, a second campaign was initiated to raise \$240,000 to build these properties. It was decided to start with schools and temporarily use the gymnasiums as churches.

A new eight-room classroom addition was planned for St. Francis High School, to accommodate a junior high school. Father Murnane also intended to construct a new high school at a different location, allowing all of St. Mary's Grade School to be relocated to the 18th and Jefferson Street site, creating a sixteen-room grade school there. Construction began on the junior high school on January 9, 1955, followed by work on the schools at the other sites.

¿SABÍAS ESTO SOBRE SANTA MARÍA?

Rev. Francis P. Leipzig 1929 - 1950

El padre Edmund J. Murnane se convirtió en el nuevo párroco de la parroquia de Sta. María en septiembre de 1950. Sus prioridades iniciales eran reparar la iglesia y construir una adición de ladrillos para oficinas en el frente de la rectoría. La ampliación estaba conectada con el vestíbulo de la iglesia por un pasillo y albergaba una nueva biblioteca parroquial. La biblioteca, que inicialmente constaba de doscientos libros, fue una donación del padre Murnane.

Además, era necesario crear más espacio para las aulas de la escuela. El establecimiento de la nueva escuela secundaria San Francisco y la apertura de una escuela católica en Sta. Alicia en 1953 brindaron oportunidades a los niños que anteriormente no podían asistir a escuelas católicas. El "baby boom" de la posguerra provocó condiciones de hacinamiento en todas las escuelas. En consecuencia, en 1952, se iniciaron planes para construir una tercera adición a las unidades existentes construidas en 1940 y 1947. Esta adición consistiría en una estructura de dos pisos con ocho aulas, extendiendo la escuela a lo largo de toda la cuadra entre las calles 10 y 11. Calles que dan a Lincoln Street. A pesar de los esfuerzos por recaudar 250.000 dólares para este proyecto, la campaña no alcanzó su objetivo y el plan nunca se ejecutó.

El padre Murnane y otros se dieron cuenta de que la parroquia de Sta. María era demasiado grande y debía dividirse en varias parroquias. El dinero recaudado en la campaña de 1952 se utilizó para comprar propiedades en otras partes de la ciudad para futuras parroquias. El plan del padre Murnane incluía la reubicación de la iglesia Sta. María en la propiedad de la calle 18, financiada con la venta del bloque de la calle Charlelton a intereses comerciales. Sin embargo, la construcción de centros comerciales en áreas suburbanas cambió el desarrollo de la ciudad y el plan nunca se materializó. Aunque la Iglesia de Sta. María nunca fue reubicada, los planes para las otras parroquias avanzaron. Un tramo de diez acres en el distrito de River Road y un tramo de veintiséis acres en el distrito escolar de Washington se convirtieron en los sitios de las parroquias de San Pedro y San Pablo, respectivamente. En 1954, se inició una segunda campaña para recaudar 240.000 dólares para construir estas propiedades. Se decidió empezar con las escuelas y utilizar temporalmente los gimnasios como iglesias.

Se planeó una nueva adición de aulas de ocho salones para la escuela secundaria San Francisco, para dar cabida a una escuela secundaria. El padre Murnane también tenía la intención de construir una nueva escuela secundaria en una ubicación diferente, permitiendo que toda la escuela primaria Sta. María se reubicara en el sitio de 18th y Jefferson Street, creando allí una escuela primaria de dieciséis aulas. La construcción de la escuela secundaria comenzó el 9 de enero de 1955, seguida de trabajos en las escuelas en los otros sitios. Continuará
