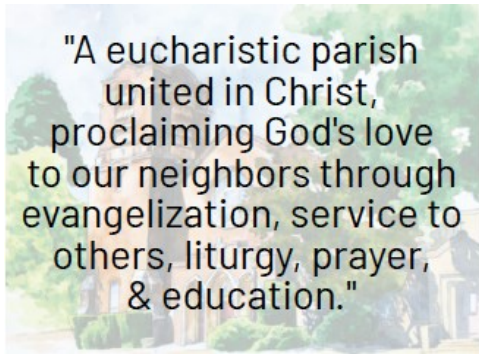

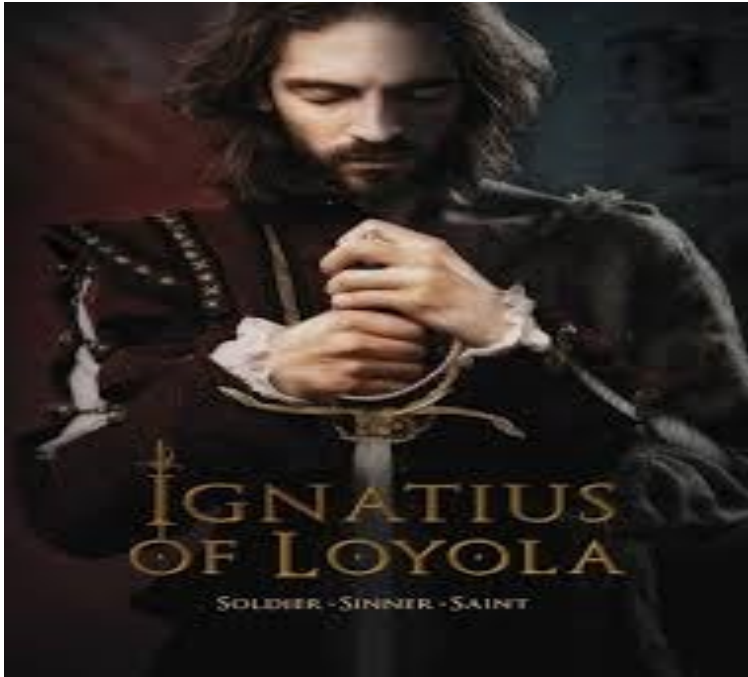

DID YOU KNOW THIS ABOUT ST. MARY?

Rev. Edmund Murnane 1950-1969

Monsignor Murnane was dedicated to constructing a new high school and centralizing the grade school on the Jefferson Street site. As a result, he acquired a twenty-eight-acre piece of land in north Eugene. In 1965, he initiated discussions with the Marist Brothers of Poughkeepsie, New York, to oversee and staff the school with the assistance of the Sisters of the Holy Names and lay teachers. By March 1965, the plans had progressed enough to be announced. The original goal was to build the first unit to accommodate 1,000 students in co-instructional classes. Two Marist Brothers were set to join the St. Francis High School staff to assist in implementing the plan. Brother Timothy Joseph arrived that fall and was appointed assistant principal at St. Francis in January 1966. Subsequently, in September, two more Marist Brothers, Brother Cronan Halsey and Brother Dennis Dunne, joined him on the St. Francis faculty, the St. Francis faculty.

The construction of the new High School was approved by the Archdiocesan Board of Education on October 19, 1966. Groundbreaking began in May 1967. Over the following year, six buildings and connecting breezeways were constructed for \$1,875,000. This cost included state-of-the-art furniture and equipment for science, music, art, home economics, a shop, a library, a chapel, and classrooms. The school was designed to accommodate 600 students but opened its doors to 400 students on September 9, 1968. The faculty and staff in its first year included ten Marist Brothers, eight Sisters of the Holy Names, and six full-time and four part-time lay persons, with Brother Timothy Joseph serving as principal.

After relocating the high school to the new building, the lower grades of St. Mary's School were moved from 11th and Lincoln Streets to the vacated rooms at 18th and Jefferson. After a year of painting, repairing, and renovating, much of the work done by parishioners, the move was completed in July 1969. Finally, all eight grades were together again in one building. However, around this time the population trends led to a decline in grade school enrollment, which continued for several years.

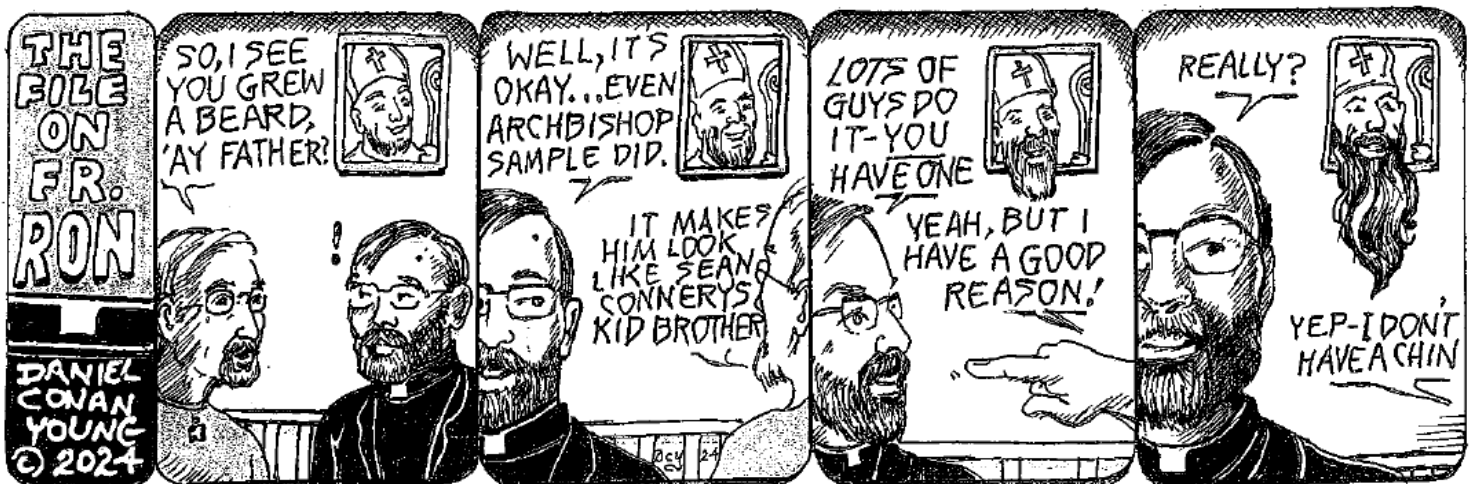

¿SABÍAS ESTO SOBRE SANTA MARÍA?

Rev. Edmund J. Murnane 1929 - 1950

Monseñor Murnane se dedicó a construir una nueva escuela secundaria y centralizar la escuela primaria en el sitio de Jefferson Street. Como resultado, adquirió un terreno de veintiocho acres en el norte de Eugene. En 1965, inició conversaciones con los Hermanos Maristas de Poughkeepsie, New York, para supervisar y dotar de personal a la escuela con la ayuda de las Hermanas de los Santos Nombres y maestros laicos. En marzo de 1965, los planes habían avanzado lo suficiente como para ser anunciados. El objetivo original era construir la primera unidad para acomodar a 1000 estudiantes en clases de co-instrucción. Dos hermanos maristas se unirían al personal de la escuela secundaria San Francisco para ayudar en la implementación del plan. El hermano Timothy Joseph llegó ese otoño y fue nombrado subdirector de San Francisco en enero de 1966. Posteriormente, en septiembre, dos hermanos maristas más, el hermano Cronan Halsey y el hermano Dennis Dunne, se unieron a él en la facultad de St. Francis.

La construcción de la nueva escuela secundaria fue aprobada por la Junta Arquidiocesana de Educación el 19 de octubre de 1966. La primera piedra comenzó en mayo de 1967. Durante el año siguiente, se construyeron seis edificios y corredores de conexión por \$1,875,000. Este costo incluyó muebles y equipos de última generación para ciencia, música, arte, economía doméstica, una tienda, una biblioteca, una capilla y aulas. La escuela fue diseñada para albergar a 600 estudiantes, pero abrió sus puertas a 400 estudiantes el 9 de septiembre de 1968. El cuerpo docente y el personal en su primer año incluyeron diez Hermanos Maristas, ocho Hermanas de los Santos Nombres y seis de tiempo completo y cuatro de tiempo parcial. tiempo laicos, siendo el hermano Timothy Joseph el principal.

Después de trasladar la escuela secundaria al nuevo edificio, los grados inferiores de la escuela Sta. María se trasladaron de las calles 11 y Lincoln a las salas desocupadas en 18 y Jefferson. Después de un año de pintar, reparar y renovar gran parte del trabajo realizado por los feligreses, la mudanza se completó en julio de 1969. Finalmente, los ocho grados estuvieron juntos nuevamente en un solo edificio. Sin embargo, en esta época las tendencias demográficas llevaron a una disminución en la matriculación en la escuela primaria, que continuó durante varios años.

Nota del editor: Han pasado 55 años desde que el edificio de la antigua escuela Sta. María se llenó de estudiantes y se utilizó con regularidad. Espero ver este edificio histórico recuperado como parte del presente y futuro de nuestra parroquia, no solo como parte de nuestro pasado. Continuará
