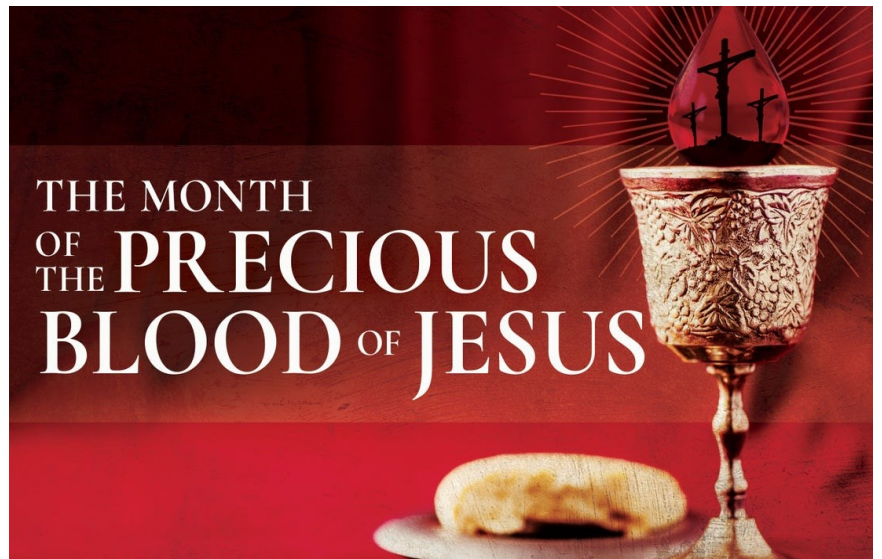

SUMMER CINEMA ON FORMED

Ignatius of Loyola

This modern and very human take on the story of St. Ignatius of Loyola, the founder of the Jesuits, often called the "Saint of Second Chances," is an incisive and thrilling look at the life of the real man behind the legend. In his lifelong quest to become the heroic knight of his fantasies, Ignatius stares death in the face again and again, having his leg shattered by a cannonball in battle, driven near suicide by his inner demons, finding himself imprisoned, accused of being an illuminati, and finally his life in the hands of the inquisition. Through it all he would come to see the hand of God working in his life, shaping the self-obsessed sinner into the loyal and impassioned soldier saint.

DID YOU KNOW THIS ABOUT ST. MARY?

Rev. Edmund Murnane 1950-1969

The establishment of St. Peter and St. Paul parishes helped alleviate some of the demands on St. Mary. It became clear that additional places of worship were necessary in the newly developed areas of Eugene. St. Mark was the third parish created and Father Cornelius J. Linehan was appointed pastor in 1961. A parish hall was the first structure built on the ten-acre land acquired in 1956. Although the first Mass was planned for September 15, 1961, a fire, caused by faulty machinery, destroyed it before the Mass could happen. Fortunately, the majority of the cost was covered by insurance. However, Mass had to be conducted in a public school building until a new hall was constructed and consecrated by Archbishop Howard in 1963.

A fourth parish in Eugene developed out of the Newman Center at the University of Oregon. As early as 1961 plans to enlarge the center at 749 East 15th Street were being discussed with the encouragement of Father Murnane. Ground was broken on June 1, 1965, for a new \$100,000 Newman Student Center on Emerald Street, south of 18th Avenue. Dominican priest staffed the center and offered Masses there for two years before Archbishop Dwyer installed Father Eugene Sousa, O.P., as pastor of the new parish on October 3, 1967. Given the name St. Thomas More, this parish has no boundaries since its prime purpose is to serve the faculty and students of the university.

As new housing developments started to cover the South hills of Eugene, a fifth new parish was established. Mass was conducted every Sunday beginning in February 1967 in the Spencer Butte Junior High School Gymnasium. St. Jude became an independent parish in 1969 when Father Hugh Gearin was appointed pastor just before Monsignor Murnane's term ended. The church was not built until 1972, but Monsignor Murnane had the foresight to purchase the property for it.

Despite rumors that Eugene would become the seat of a southern Oregon diocese, this never materialized. However, in 1960, the pastor of St. Mary parish was honored with the title of "Monsignor," a recognition the Pope can use to honor priests with outstanding accomplishments and exemplary lives. Monsignor Edmund J. Murnane was one of six priests in the archdiocese to receive this honorary title, and he truly deserved it. To be continued.

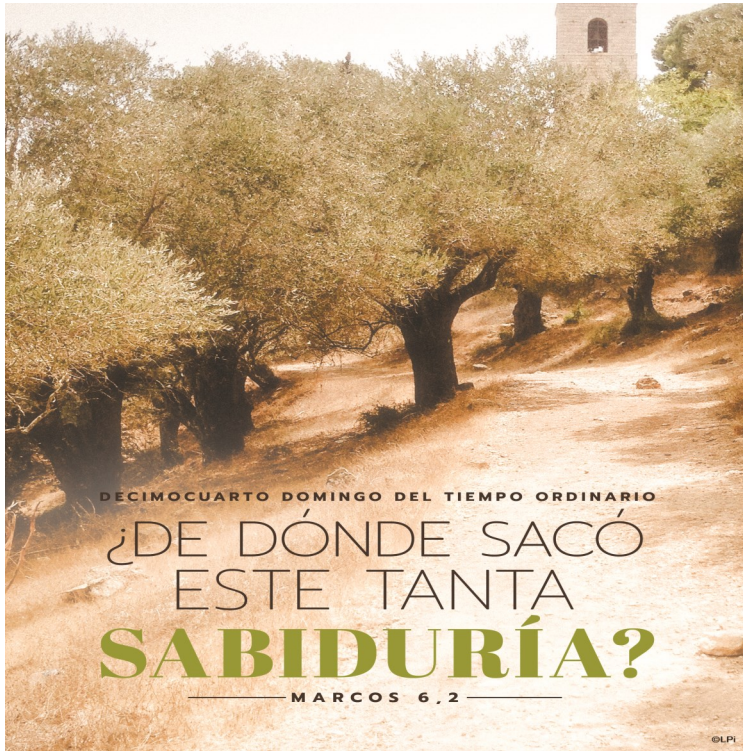

¿SABÍAS ESTO SOBRE SANTA MARÍA?

Rev. Edmund J. Murnane 1929 - 1950

El establecimiento de las parroquias de San Pedro y San Pablo ayudó a aliviar algunas de las demandas de Santa María. Quedó claro que eran necesarios lugares de culto adicionales en las áreas recientemente desarrolladas de Eugene. San Marcos fue la tercera parroquia creada y el Padre Cornelius J. Linehan fue nombrado párroco en 1961. Un salón parroquial fue la primera estructura construida en el terreno de diez acres adquirido en 1956. Aunque la primera misa estaba prevista para el 15 de septiembre de 1961, un incendio, provocado por una maquinaria defectuosa, la destruyó antes de que pudiera celebrarse la misa. Afortunadamente, la mayor parte del coste lo cubrió el seguro. Sin embargo, la misa tuvo que celebrarse en el edificio de una escuela pública hasta que el arzobispo Howard construyó y consagró un nuevo salón en 1963.

Una cuarta parroquia en Eugene se desarrolló a partir del Centro Newman de la Universidad de Oregon. Ya en 1961 se estaban discutiendo planes para ampliar el centro en 749 East 15th Street con el apoyo del Padre Murnane. El 1 de junio de 1965 se inició la construcción de un nuevo Centro de Estudiantes Newman de \$ 100,000 en Emerald Street, al sur de 18th Avenue. El sacerdote dominico trabajó en el centro antes de que el Arzobispo Dwyer instalara al Padre Eugene Sousa, O.P., como párroco de la nueva parroquia el 3 de octubre de 1967. Dado el nombre de Santo Tomás Moro, esta parroquia no tiene límites ya que su propósito principal es servir a la facultad y estudiantes de la universidad.

A medida que nuevos desarrollos de viviendas comenzaron a cubrir las colinas del sur de Eugene, se estableció una quinta parroquia nueva. La misa se celebró todos los domingos a partir de febrero de 1967 en el gimnasio de la escuela secundaria Spencer Butte. St. Jude se convirtió en parroquia independiente en 1969 cuando el padre Hugh Gearin fue nombrado párroco justo antes de que terminara el mandato de monseñor Murnane. La iglesia no se construyó hasta 1972, pero Monseñor Murnane tuvo la previsión de comprar la propiedad para ella.

A pesar de los rumores de que Eugene se convertiría en la sede de una diócesis del sur de Oregón, esto nunca se materializó. Sin embargo, en 1960, el párroco de la parroquia de Santa María fue honrado con el título de "Monseñor", un reconocimiento que el Papa puede utilizar para honrar a sacerdotes con logros sobresalientes y vidas ejemplares. Monseñor Edmund J. Murnane fue uno de los seis sacerdotes de la arquidiócesis que recibieron este título honorífico y verdaderamente lo merecía. Continuará
