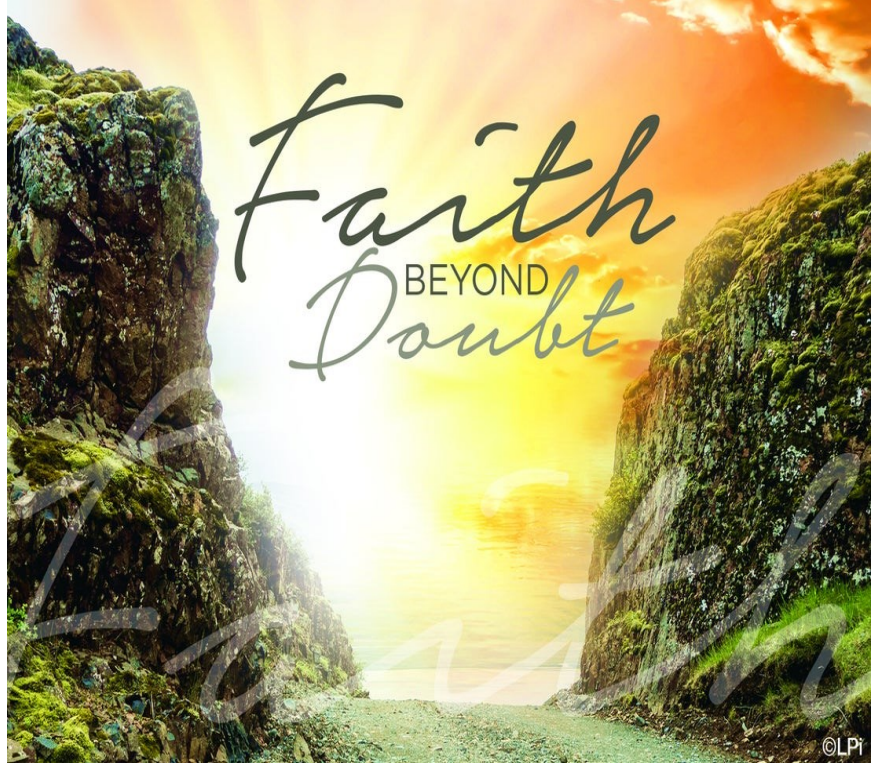

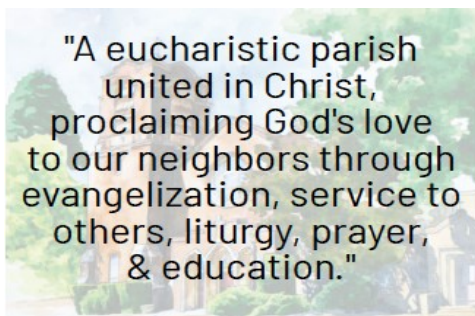

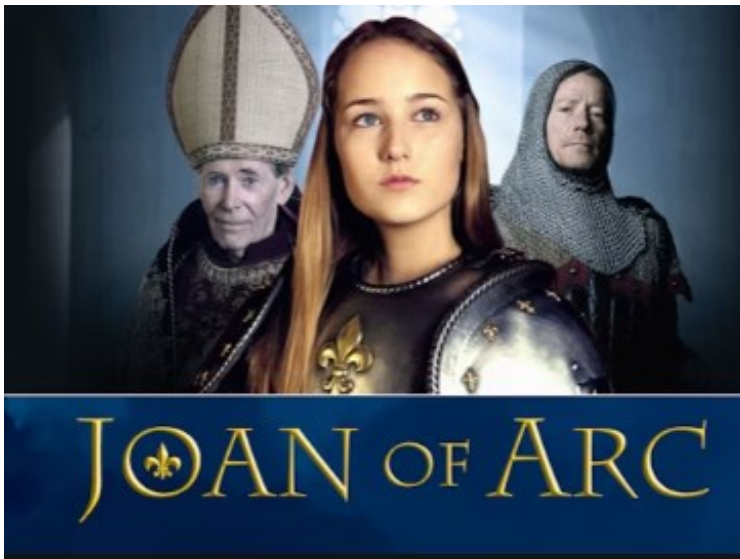

### Joan of Arc

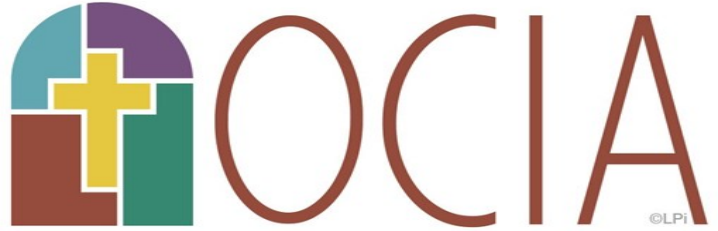

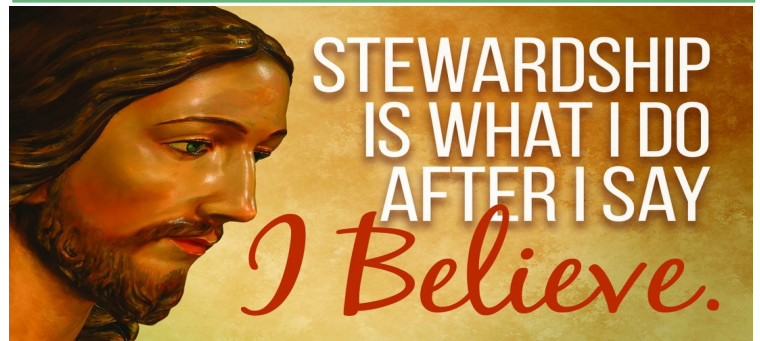
